church memorial 44 names





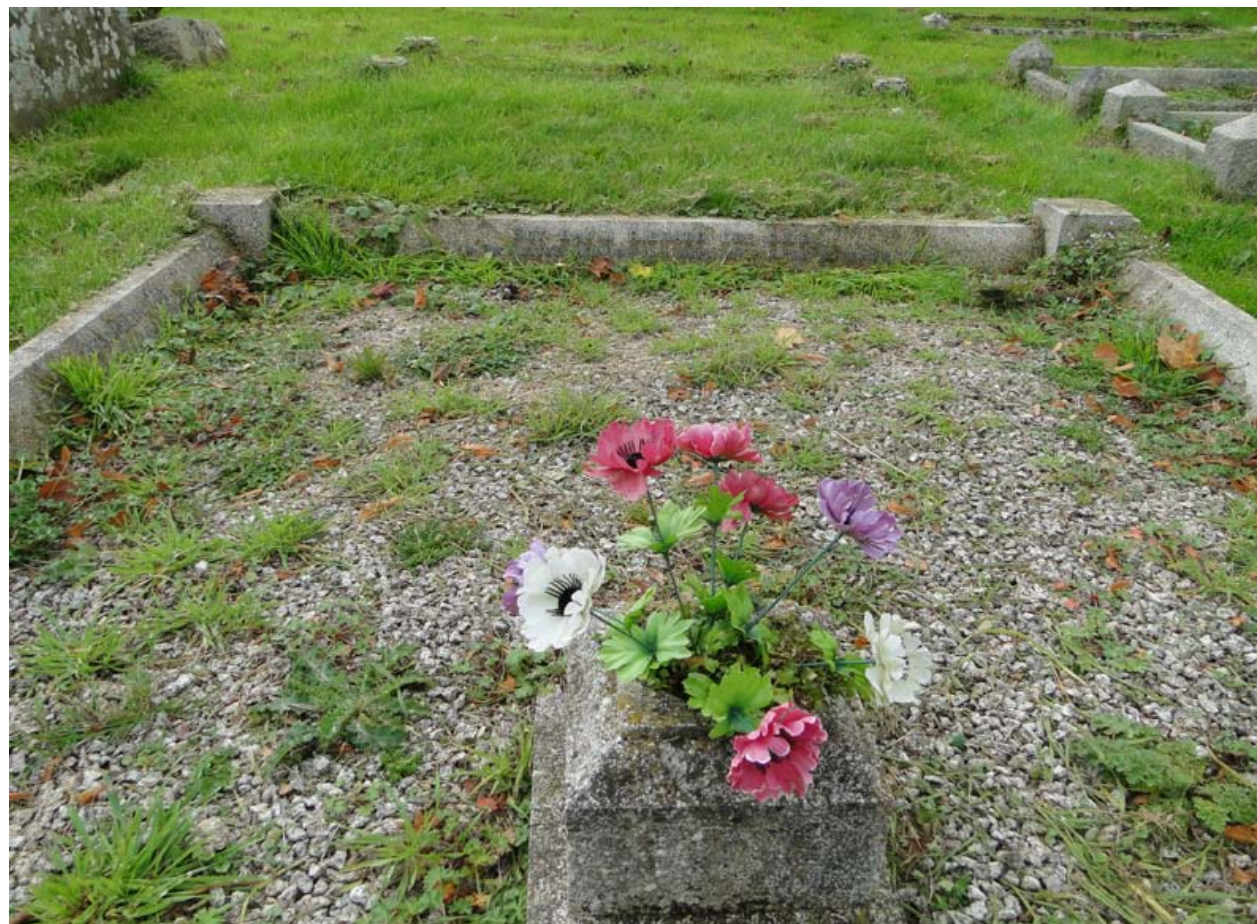
