
Felixstowe (Walton) CEMETERY

Why it was decided to do it this way is anybody's guess but the headstones are lined up against a wall as if they were facing a firing squad.

Not what I would personally consider an appropriate arrangement.

It is thought that these men (with the exception of Albert HAYES) may have died in training.


